COVID-19 Outbreak Prairie Neighborhood Declared OVER

Good morning everyone,

The COVID-19 outbreak on Prairie Neighborhood has been declared over. Effective immediately, Prairie will join the rest of Samaritan Place and return to Level 1 Family Presence Guidelines which allows for two essential family/support persons designated for each resident.

As of **MONDAY morning, November 22nd**, Samaritan Place will transition to Recovery Phase of Family Presence which means:

- There are no limits on the number of essential family/support persons or visitors that can be designated or present at one time (during indoor or outdoor visits) for each resident.
- Frequency of family presence can be daily.
- Timing of in-person visits may be subject to scheduling limitations of the home. We request visitation be limited to between 11 am and 7pm when we have a screener present.
- Everyone is required to follow SHA guidelines for screening, proof of vaccination or negative test, personal protective equipment and distancing, even if vaccinated.
